

CAMPERS' PARADISE - CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **All campers** must register at the office upon arrival. **All non-camping visitors must leave the island by 9 p.m.** All vehicles must display a parking tag.
2. **CAMPGROUND QUIET HOURS** are from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m., 7 days a week.
3. **All GARBAGE must be deposit in the dumpster located on the West road just North of the baseball field.** All garbage must be bagged. If needed, garbage bags are available for sale in the office. Garbage may be deposited at any time, however, we ask that **all garbage be deposited before dark to avoid foraging animals.** Labeled recycling containers are distributed throughout the campground and by the dumpster. Please use them accordingly.
4. Due to the high volume of pedestrian and bicycle traffic with limited visibility on the winding and heavily wooded roads, **please adhere to all posted speed limits.** (Main road: 10 mph; ALL other roads: 5 mph). All motorized vehicles must be operated by licensed drivers only. Careless, reckless or drunken driving will not be tolerated.
5. **GENERATOR QUIET HOURS – PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY.** Charging generators between 10 a.m. to NOON and 4 to 6 p.m. is appropriate. This allows for peaceful mornings and evenings for your neighbors on the Island.
6. **Pets** and their behavior are the sole responsibility of their owners. Please remember, barking dogs can be very disturbing to your fellow campers. Pets must be leashed at all times. It is **ALWAYS** the owner's responsibility to clean up after their pets.
7. For **safety purposes** pedestrians and bicycles must give the right-of-way to motorized vehicles on all roads, causeway and bridge.
8. Children 5 years and under must be accompanied by an adult while using the main shower/bathroom facilities.

9. **No firearms** of any kind are permitted at Campers' Paradise. This includes BB guns, pellet guns, sling shots or similar projectiles.

10. Campers' Paradise does not allow motor bikes, ATVs, dune buggies or unusually loud vehicles.

11. Maintaining the forest on our island is a difficult job. Bushes and trees around and between the campsites are there to ensure privacy. Please do not walk off your campsite perimeter or place anything on it that would damage the area. We plant seedlings around and between the sites each year, but only a small percentage of them grow. If you have the urge to water a seedling, it would be greatly appreciated. **If you see someone damaging the forest, please let us know immediately!**

12. Please respect your surroundings, the island and its accommodations. Willful damage to **ANY** Campers' Paradise properties, including plants and wildlife, could result in eviction, without refund, and the legal pursuit of claims for damages.

13. Campers' Paradise has a ZERO TOLERANCE for late night loud gatherings, profanity, public intoxication, underage drinking, excessive late night vehicle traffic, and operation of motor vehicles while under the influence of alcohol or legally banned substances. Failure to observe these simple rules of consideration and safety will result in eviction and/or arrest. Vandals will most definitely be prosecuted!

EURASIAN WATER MILFOIL

All private watercraft brought onto the island must be cleaned before it arrives. This includes boat, motor, trailer, oars, anchor, rope and extraneous floatation devices and toys.

EMERALD ASH BORER

The transportation of firewood INTO Campers' Paradise is prohibited. Personal firewood brought from home is not allowed.
