Rates

- We allow *one* family/camping unit per site, unless prearranged with us. A family is considered a parent(s) & dependent children.
- Anyone camping with you who is not an immediate family member, as described above, is considered an extra person and will be charged \$10/day. Any non-camping visitors will be charged \$10 each.
- All rates are subject to change without notice.
- Please observe our check-in/check-out times. Campers arriving before 1 p.m. or leaving after 11 a.m. will be charged for an extra day. This also applies if you pull your camping equipment into a friend's or relative's site before or after our check-in/check-out times.
- Payment is by **check or cash only—no credit cards.**

Campsites

- A nonrefundable deposit of \$70/family/reservation/site is required for all campsites.
- All sites are electric.

Reservation information

- A \$70 deposit is required for each family in a site. Reservations will be held for 24 hours.
- Reservations of six or more days receive preference for a given site. The seventh consecutive day is free.
- Deposits are **nonrefundable**.

- All campers and guests check in at the office upon arrival.

- Campers observe our 36-foot limit on camping equipment.
- Campers fill water tanks at our central shower facility, since we don't have water hook-ups.
- Dogs are kept leashed.
- Boaters inspect and clean their boats to prevent contaminating our beautiful lake with Eurasian milfoil and other invasive species.
- No firewood may be brought onto the island to protect our forest from Emerald Ash Borer. Quality firewood is available for sale at the office.
